- Collaborate with the senior engineers to create project parameters and specification.
- Working closely with suppliers and vendors to set equipment or system design requirements, timing and completion schedules.
- Project management of multiple projects within multiple facilities.
- Open to learning new systems within the facilities to expand your knowledge and expertise in finding solutions, or Help in determining budgets for projects.
- Help in developing the specification for all equipment that is required for each project. Oversight of projects for compliance to design, budget and installation requirements.
- Continue to stay educated on equipment or system advancements and their benefits to our existing equipment and systems.
