Qualifications: The applicant must submit to a Federally Mandated Pre-employment Drug test. Be able to pass both a DOT and Company physical. A driver must be at least 23 years old and have two years verifiable over the road commercial vehicle driving experience, refer experience preferred and have a current Class A License. A clean driving record for the last three years is preferred. Receive no unfavorable references from any employers during the past three years. If an unfavorable reference is received, the Transportation Manager will evaluate and discuss with the Human Resource Manager. Demonstrate driving ability by satisfactorily completing a Brakebush Transportation, Inc. road test over a predetermined course.

Job Summary: To safely transport and deliver freight by driving diesel powered tractor-trailer combinations long distances. This may include the following duties:

- Hook and unhook trailers from the tractor using the cranking lever to raise and lower landing gear on semi-trailers
- As required, load and unload trailers, either individually or with assistance of dock workers, with or without mechanical freight handling equipment.
- Inspect the truck for defects and safe operating condition before, during and after trips and submit a written report on the condition of the truck at the end of each trip or tour of duty as required by Federal Regulation.
- Install and remove tire chains as required by State law or dictated by weather conditions.
- Operate vehicle in accordance with all company and Federal Regulations.
- Ensure all shipping documentation (manifest, security seals, bills of lading, shipping orders, freight bills, etc.) required to move with shipments are available for inspection and to ensure appropriate paperwork accompanies a shipment when deliveries are made.
- Maintain records, as required, to comply with State and Federal Regulations and company policy, including drivers' logs, fuel purchases, mileage records, etc.
- Perform all duties in accordance with company policies, procedures and regulatory interpretations, and comply with all Federal, State and Local regulations for safe operations of a commercial motor vehicle.
- Report all accidents involving driver or company equipment immediately.
- Report highway safety hazards noted en route.

- Promptly report any delays en route due to breakdown, weather or traffic conditions or other emergencies, or in the event of irregularities related to the pickup and/or delivery of cargo.
- Other duties as assigned.
